

WEANTINOGE HERITAGE LAND TRUST

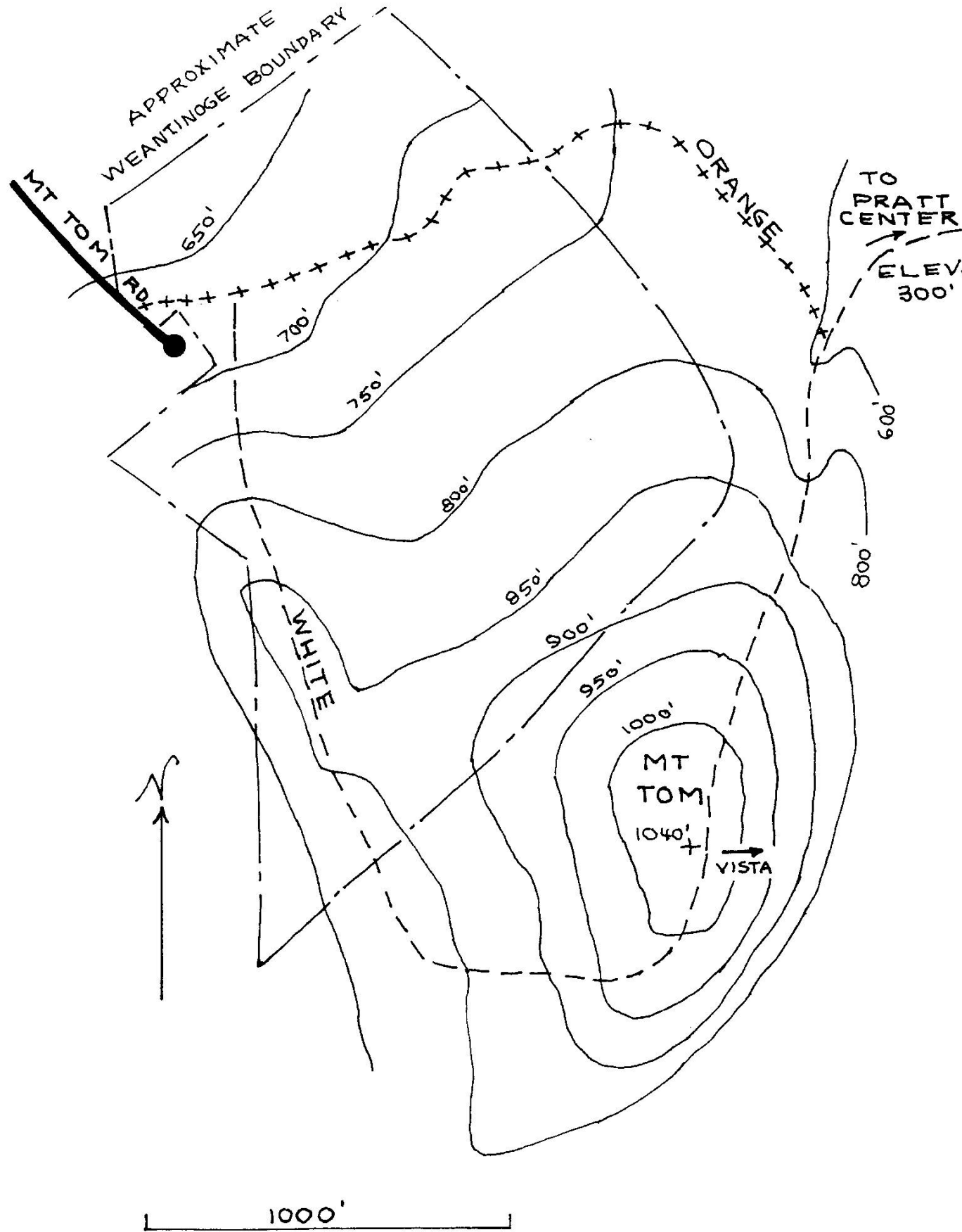
Mt. Tom Preserve, New Milford, 50 acres

OVERVIEW: Easy walking. 1¼ miles round-trip from Mt. Tom Road.

HIGHLIGHTS: For over 25 years, the Pratt Nature Center has maintained a trail system to the summit of Mt. Tom. During the late 1980s Weantinoge and the New Milford Youth Agency created a trail to the Center starting from the top of Mt. Tom Road. Weantinoge has protected three major parcels of land to buffer the Center and Mt. Tom. Along the trail, you may see vernal pools and lofty tulip poplars. The map below shows the locations of the Pratt Nature Center and Weantinoge's Mt. Tom Preserve, Kahn Preserve, and the Lappin Bird Sanctuary.
